Philippine Americans show support for Military Recruiters After Chattanooga Attack kills 4 Marines

Demands Politicians "Stop Disarming our Servicemen"

The U.S. Marine Corps Recruiting Office at 315 Loucks Road, York PA received a visit from representatives of the local Philippine American Heritage Council carrying flowers, a large American flag and a poster to express sympathy and support for the armed forces after the shooting in Chattanooga, Tennessee and killing of four servicemen yesterday.

The message from the Americans of Philippine ancestry and their native born American members on a tripod placed in front of the Marine and Army recruiting office with the flowers and the large American flag was headlined "We mourn our Loss. We thank all who serve."

The message was aimed at recruiters at the U.S. Marine Corps and U.S. Army Recruiting Station and also the nearby U.S. Air Force and U.S. Navy Recruiting offices at 351 Loucks Road, after the killing of four American Marines and wounding of three others yesterday in an attack on the Marine recruiting center in Chattanooga, Tennessee.

A case of energy drinks on ice was also delivered "to keep our servicemen fired up to continue defending our freedom" said a representative of the council.
